Bringing it Home – Family Activity

Chapter 3 – Fairness

As an extension of our learning, learners will periodically complete a *Bringing it Home* activity. They will interview a family member about a real-life experience connected to a specific character strength, such as Fairness, Self-Control, or Bravery.

The goal of these interviews is to encourage meaningful conversation and reflection, while helping your child notice how these superpowers show up in everyday life.

After completing the home interview, learners bring what they recorded below to the next session and share what they learned. They will then paste their notes into their journal as a record of their family story and personal learning.

Fairness is the power to treat others with respect and give everyone an equal chance. It means we must listen to different sides and do what is right even when it would be easier to think only about ourselves.

I hope that this *Bringing it Home* will be the start of a meaningful conversation about Fairness.

Thank you for talking about your experience with this character strength and for your partnership in building a greater understanding and appreciation of superpowers.
