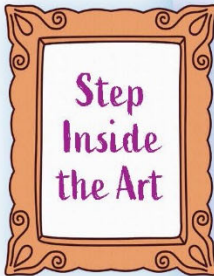
Throughout the year, you will receive “Step Inside the Art” activities to discuss with your child.

Kindness: You are generous to others and don't expect anything in return. You enjoy doing good deeds for other people.

Your child discussed this “Step Inside the Art” piece when learning about Rebekah and the superpower of Kindness. To begin a meaningful conversation with your child, ask them what they discussed with their group and to share their thoughts about the art. Then it is your turn to look at the art and respond to the questions.

Thank you for partnering in building your child’s understanding and appreciation of Torah and positive character strengths.

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The story of Rebekah at the well has inspired artists for centuries. With your *hevruta*, examine the artwork below and discuss:

- What do you notice about how Rebekah gives the water to the servant?
- What do you think the artist wants to convey about Rebekah?
- What may have stopped others from offering water to the servant and his camels?
- Step inside the painting. Take on the role of an onlooker or a camel, and tell what you think about Rebekah.

Share your answers with the full group.
