Make Your Own Kitty Tzedakah Box

SUPPLIES


- 1 empty oatmeal container and lid
- scissors
- construction paper
 - o yellow
 - o orange
 - o pink
- 2 large googly eyes stickers
- black marker
- printout of template
- tape



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Cut out a circle of orange paper and glue it to the top of the lid.
- 2. Cut a rectangle slot on the lid. It should be large enough for a quarter to fit through.
- **3.** Cover the outside of the oatmeal container with orange construction paper. Tape or glue into place. Trim off any extra paper.
- **4.** Place the template onto a separate sheet of the orange paper. Cut out the large triangles (ears) and the tail.
- **5.** Place the template onto a sheet of yellow paper. Cut out the smaller triangles for the inside of the ears.
- **6.** Tape the yellow triangles to the center of the orange triangles. Then tape the two ears to the back of the container.
- **7.** Place the template onto a sheet of the pink paper and cut out the pink nose. Tape it to the front of the container.
- **8.** Use a black marker to draw stripes on the tail, and whiskers and mouth on the face (see template for guidance).
- **9.** Attach the googly eyes in place.
- **10.** Tape the tail to the back of the container.
